The Seventeenth Sunday after Trinity

The parish centre recently had to deal with a request for a baptism certificate. That doesn't normally mean much more than a bit of an exploration in the archive, a photo of a page in the register, and so on. Many of us actually enjoy a visit back in time to generations of our congregations past. The problem arose because there was an error in the register entry, which complicates the picture considerably.

It turns out that in order to correct an error in the register of baptisms, one needs the Team Rector to make a correction. (You may have noticed that for the time being, that office is vacant.) But absent the Team Rector, the Team Vicar can make the correction — but only in the presence of the churchwardens. We did have a Team Vicar at the time (indeed, we still do have him, though he's on leave), but we don't have both churchwardens available to witness the correction. By the time we have the churchwardens back, we will have neither Team Rector nor Team Vicar, and the Associate Priest isn't a satisfactory substitute. Everything will be sorted, but the parish's Great Offices of State are beginning to look a bit dusty and... well, vacant.

Speaking as — for the days between our farewell to Fr Paul and our welcome of Jen in her new role as Team Rector — the ranking member of the licensed clergy team, it can feel a little like the words of the prophet Elijah, who would have said (were he serving our parish), 'I have been very zealous for the LORD, the God of hosts; but the Team Rector has retired, and the Team Vicar has retired, and the Associate Priest is on leave; and I, I alone, am left.' But truly, no worries: in a few days, Jen will be instituted, we'll begin looking for a Team Vicar, and all our churches will keep the marvellous forward momentum that has kept us so strong for the past months.
